Blissful beach & Island hopping with historical culture

Day 1-2	You will be met at the airport and shown to your transfer vehicle for the approx. 3-hour road transfer to Mucojo. Arrive Mucojo and dhow transfer to Mogundula Island. You will spend 2 nights at the mobile camp, set under the shade of the trees on the lovely, uninhabited Mogundula Island. Known by the locals as the island with the sacred lake it provides us with beautiful bird watching, pristine swimming off the sandbank beach and excellent snorkeling.
Day 3-4	Sail into the clearest of blue water with pristine corals below to explore under snorkel. The Ulumbwa river mouth beckons and it is here where fascinating rural fishing villages dot the shore. Your chance to camp in the open Mozambique bush south of Ulumbwa. Turquoise clear waters and beautiful scenery awaits you en route, but before enjoy an early morning sail up the Ulumbwa estuary viewing a variety of birds & mangroves that thrive in this area. In the afternoon, take a tour through this fishing village getting to know the ways of these fisher folk as interpreted by your knowledgeable guide. We will stop on the southern tip of Matemo Island and explore this part of the island. Returning to our camp at Ulumbwa.
Day 5-8	Spend 3 nights in a garden room at the elegant Ibo Island Lodge, enjoy guided tours around the island, photographing the grand, majestic architecture and ruins, soaking in the history and culture of the island and its inhabitants. Get lost in time on one of the oldest and World-Heritage-nominated islands. Be whisked away to an idyllic white sandbank beach for days of sun and snorkel. Search for dolphins in the archipelago, dive or kayak looking for birds in the mangroves. Or simply relax the days away at the pool surrounded by the luscious, manicured gardens at the lodge.
Day 6-10	Transfer by air back to Pemba, in time for your LAM connection to Nampula International Airport**, and be transferred effortlessly by road to Nuarro Lodge. Enjoy the sights and sounds of rural Mozambique along the way of the 4 hour journey. Kick back and chill out at Nuarro for the next 5 days, where you can spend the daylight hours whale watching, diving, snorkeling, chilling out on the 2km-long white beach, mountain biking to the nearby village or reading a book in your hand-built, very private, spacious beachfront chalet. Nuarro is the perfect place to escape from the hustle and bustle of everyday life! Return by road, after an early breakfast, back to Nampula airport in time for your international connection.***
